Things You Should be Doing Right Now:

- ⇒ Complete and submit those local scholarships. See the yellow sheet I handed out in December to see the full list of local scholarship opportunities.
- ⇒ File your FAFSA. Most scholarships require your EFC and you can only get that number by filing the FAFSA. See Mrs. H to set up a time to complete the important application.
- → Males: Just a reminder to all male students sign up with the Selective Service within 30 days of your 18th birthday to stay eligible for federal student loans, government jobs and job training. You may register at your local post office or at www.ssss.gov.
- ⇒ Sign up to take the ASVAB test if you are going into the military or want to know more about which career best fits you.

What is the ASVAB test?



The ASVAB is offered to high school and post-secondary students as part of the ASVAB Career Exploration Program. The program provides tools to help students learn more about ⇒ career exploration and planning, in both the civilian and

military worlds of work

 $\Rightarrow \;$ is the entrance exam for the military (if you choose to go into the military)

The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is <u>free</u> of charge. You do not have to be considering going into the military to take this test. It gives phenomenal results to all students regarding Career Exploration too. The HATC offers this test in February. Contact Mrs. Hessling if you are interested in taking it. If I have enough interest here, I will set up a date to test here at HBCS.

MiSSG Student Portal

The MiSSG Student Portal provides students access to their MiSSG account. To have access to MiSSG, our office must have received the student's FAFSA (typically 3-4 days after submission) or a TIP record must exist.

- First-time users must have their SSN when signing up.
- TIP eligible students may create a student account, complete their TIP application, and update their college selection online. When a student completes a TIP application, the college that they select is notified of their TIP status.
 - Should the student change their college choice, they need to update it on the MiSSG Student Portal or by contacting our office.

The College Payment Authorization letters that were previously used are no longer printed. College financial aid administrators have a portal within MiSSG to access listings of TIP eligible students at their institution.
